

APCM and civil and military police seize over 100 thousand pirate CDs and DVDs and 100 burners in Presidente Prudente

Civil and military police, in conjunction with APCM agents, staged a large-scale antipiracy operation in the city of Presidente Prudente in the interior of São Paulo State on October 16 and 17. The raid was the consequence of work conducted in April of this year, which has removed 126 burners and over 50 thousand pirate CDs and DVDs from the black market.

The investigation and operation itself have yielded very positive results, with the seizure of more than 100 thousand pirate CDs and DVDs at the Camelódromo Central (an area of street stalls), some 100 CD and DVD burners in two laboratories, and a clandestine printing facility. Two people were also arrested in the commission of the crime and several were charged with copyright violation under article 184 of the Brazilian Penal Code.

The raid was reported by the main regional TV and radio stations, among which: Rede Globo, Record, SBT, Oeste Notícias, O Imparcial, Comercial, and Jovem Pan.
